

Promotion policy for class-XI, 2022-23

The following criteria would be followed for the promotion of a student to class XII (while preparing the final result of class-XI, session 2022-23)

Either Criteria-1

Weightage: (15% of Weekly Tests) + (15% of Half Yearly Examination) + (70% of Annual Examination)

- A student scoring 33% marks overall (i.e. WT1+HYE+WT2+AE) as per weightage mentioned above in theory paper of each subject would be declared promoted to class XII.

OR Criteria-2

Weightage: (10% of Weekly Tests & Half Yearly Examination) + (90% of Annual Examination)

- A student scoring 33% marks in each subject as per weightage mentioned above in theory paper of each subject would be declared promoted to class XII.

Note:

1. Either Criteria-1 or Criteria-2 will be followed for preparing the result. The criteria-1 cannot be mixed with criteria-2 for any subject or for all together.
2. It is mandatory to score the passing marks in Practical Examination separately.
3. If a student does not score 33% marks in one subject out of five, he/ she will be placed in compartment category in the particular subject as per CBSE norms and one chance would be given to score minimum 33% passing marks to be eligible to be promoted to class XII.
4. If a student does not score 33% marks in more than one subject, he/ she will be declared failed (essential repeat).
5. 75% attendance is mandatory to appear in the annual examination.
